Renewal Fire Levy Fact Sheet

Election Date: November 4, 2025

Levy Renewal

- Renewing an existing *non-permanent* fire levy
- Requires citizen approval every five years last approval was in 2020
- Renewal is good for five years for the period 2025-2029
- Effective tax rate is reduced to 2.3 mills originally approved tax rate of 3.8 mills

Levy Impact

- Generates \$595,182 for the fire department annually
- Property owners contribute \$82.00 annually per \$100,000 of valuation
- Accounts for 47% of the fire departments annual tax revenue
- Sustains present service and staffing levels

Funding Use

- Funds may be used for fire department purposes only
- Levy funds are used to pay Firefighters (full and part-time) who staff the department around the clock
- Levy funds pay for Firefighter training and professional development
- Levy funds pay for Firefighter protective clothing and equipment

Fire Department Statistics

- Annual Fire and Rescue Incidents: 370
- Annual EMS Incidents: 730, on course for 526 transports in 2025
- Average Monthly Fire Incidents: 30
- Average Monthly EMS Incidents: 61
- Average response time: 3:45 (84% of response times are below 4.5 minutes)
