

APPENDIX A

DEFINITIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR NEW UTILITY POLE INSTALLATIONS

*Appendix to the Agreement Between the **Greene County Engineer** and the **Miami Township Board of Trustees***

This Appendix is adopted as a supplemental reference to the Agreement executed under **Resolution No. 2022-45**. It provides additional definitions and establishes the procedural steps governing new utility pole installations associated with fiber-optic infrastructure within the Township's jurisdiction. This Appendix does not alter or replace the original Agreement; it is intended to clarify and support its implementation.

SECTION A — DEFINITIONS

A.1 Fiber Installation

For the purpose of the Agreement and this Appendix, "fiber installation" includes overhead fiber placement, underground fiber placement, and the installation of new utility poles necessary to support fiber-optic infrastructure.

SECTION B — NEW POLE INSTALLATION PROCESS

The following steps apply to all new utility pole installations associated with fiber-optic infrastructure:

B.1 Permit Application Submission

The Utility Company submits a complete permit application to the Greene County Engineer for review.

B.2 Application Review

The Greene County Engineer's office, reviews the application for compliance with applicable regulations, standards, and right-of-way requirements.

B.3 Permit Approval

Upon satisfactory review, the Greene County Engineer approves the permit application.

B.4 Field Marking of Proposed Pole Locations

The Utility Company marks all proposed new pole locations in the field for inspection.

B.5 Initial Field Verification

A Greene County Inspector performs a field check to verify that the proposed pole locations are acceptable and consistent with the approved permit.

B.6 Joint Field Review (If needed)

If clarification or confirmation is required, a representative of the Township can request to meet Greene County inspector on site to review and confirm the proposed pole locations.

B.7 Final Approval for Installation

Once all locations are verified and accepted, the Greene County Engineer's Office provides final approval for installation to proceed.

B.8 Construction and Periodic Monitoring

The Utility Company begins installation work. The Greene County Engineer's Office staff monitors the work periodically to ensure compliance with the approved plans, standards, and any conditions of the permit.
