**RESOLUTION TO ALLOW DONATED TREES TO BE PLANTED ON BERM BETWEEN THE FIRE STATION PROPERTY AND THE CASCADES**

**Whereas** The Yellow Springs Tree Committee is donating nine trees to Yellow Springs Home, Inc., six of which will be planted along the berm that runs between the Miami Township Fire Station and YS Home Inc’s Cascades development parking area, and

**Whereas** YS Home, Inc, has requested to plant the trees in a way that will benefit the trees and enhance both properties, but which may result that the trees will encroach on or cross the property line onto the Township’s land, and

**Whereas** the Miami Township Board of Trustees approves of this plan and is satisfied that the landscape enhancement will benefit both parties, and

**Whereas** there should be no cost to the Township for these trees or their maintenance in the future, as the trees will remain the responsibility of the Tree Committee initially and then of Home, Inc.,

**Therefore be it resolved** that the Miami Township Board of Trustees take the following action:

- 1) That Home, Inc, in cooperation with the Yellow Springs Tree Committee to plant the six trees along our shared property line and we will not object to reasonable encroachment onto our property.
- 2) That the public be assured that by allowing the trees to be planted partially on our property in no way commits the Township to any responsibility for the ownership or maintenance of these six trees.
